Notes from The AGM held on 13th December 2011

- The elected committee comprises of: Chairman Peter Dixon; Secretary Brian Burgess; Treasurer – Keith Roberts; Membership Secretary – Roger Morris; Fixtures Secretary – Vacant; Honorary Auditor – David Hawkes; Other Committee Members – Alan Ashurst & Paul Tench.
- Member numbers have reduced slightly over the last 12 months with some renewals still outstanding. Currently we have 38 annual members and 21 life members. In future it was agreed that all annual memberships will be due in September each year with pro-rata reductions for renewals between December 2011 and July 2012. Annual membership subscription remains at £15.
- Admission to meetings for all members will continue to remain free; a £3 charge will be made for any visitors and lapsed members (or, of course, they can join/rejoin the Association).
- The 'Preservation Fund' listed separately in our accounts currently stands at £289. The committee will consider any suggestions to make donations from this fund back to the 'railway community'.

The 8E Railway Association 2012 Summer Outings....

Alan has once again organised three trips this year:

Tuesday June12th – Knutsford

Meet at Knutsford Station 19:00 for a short walk through the town to The Angel – a Joseph Holts hostelry at the top of King Street. Included in the evening will be something a little different – 'Things you didn't think you knew about the CLC....' Train times are 18:37 from Northwich returning at 21:59; or 18:46 from Altrincham returning at 21:49.

Saturday July 14th – Greater Manchester 'Wayfarer Day'

Meet at Manchester Piccadilly at the buffer stops, platform1, below the Woodhead Tunnel Memorial Plaque at 11.00am (09:37 ex Northwich, 10:04 ex Altrincham or tram) for 11:18 to Gorton, and thence a 60 minute level walk along eastern end of 'Fallowfield Loop Line Path' (ex-GCR) to Levenshulme. From here 12:58 train to Buxton (13:50) for exploration of rail interests in the town plus JD Wetherspoons 'Wye Bridge Inn', etc. Patrons wishing to omit the walk could depart Northwich 11:37 and connect at Stockport into the Buxton train at 13:05. Option for further beers at Whaley Bridge or Stockport in the evening are a possability.

Saturday August 11th – Manchester Museum of Science & Industry

Saturday 11th August: Meet Deansgate main line station 12:00noon (09:37 or 10:37 ex Northwich, change for tram at Altrincham or local Northern Trains services at Piccadilly) for short 'Heritage' walk around Castlefields / Manchester Central area thence (13:30 – 16:30) afternoon at 'MOSI'. Early evening option to continue to Stalybridge buffet/bar for appropriate rail-themed beers and entertainment.
